# NIH eRA Commons Release Notes Version 2.8.3.0

## General Enhancements

### Performance

This release of Commons will implement several performance changes for the **Status** page, **Internet Assisted Review (IAR)**, and **eSNAP** modules. Version 2.8.3 will also correct several defects, incorporate new sort capabilities and standardized reference links, and will add new display items to the **Status** page.

### NLM Webservices

The “Webservices” for the National Library of Medicine (NLM) is now active, where the expected response time to access data should show a great improvement.

This service is a feature that links PI-submitted publications [recorded in the PI’s **Personal Profile**] with the eSNAP. As a result, the PI does not have to manually key in these publications on the eSNAP.

### Commons Logo

The Commons logo has been redesigned. The new logo features an addition of the phrase “Sponsored by National Institutes of Health” as well as modifications in design. The new logo accommodates Operating Divisions (OPDIVs) who have begun utilizing the Commons portal.

A new menu item has been added to the eRA Commons. This menu item is a link is to a newly designed page for “eRA Partners.”




Figure 2: eRA Partners Link (COM0001)

Upon changing a password, the user will be taken to the **Personal Information** page of their **Personal Profile** so that they may verify and [if necessary] update personal information.




Figure 3: Personal Information Page (PPF6008)

The “Dup DUNS” column on the **Process Registrations** page has been moved to the left of the “E-mail Verified” column.”




Figure 4: Process Registrations Page (REG3012)

The Study Section and Council Meeting locations have been removed from the **Status Information** screen.




Figure 5: Status Information Page (STA4002)

“Initial Review Group” has been changed to read “Scientific Review Group” on the **Status Information** page.




Figure 6: Status Information Page (STA4002)

The **Fellowship** link in the Action column on the **Status Result-PI Status** page has been edited to read **Fellowship Face Page**.




Figure 7: Status Result – PI Status Page (STA4037)

## Reference Letters

New functionality has been implemented for “Reference Letter” uploads that permits a “referee” (i.e., a reference for a PI) to upload a reference letter for a principal investigator. A Commons account is not necessary to upload a reference letter.

**NOTE:** Reference letter submission is currently available only for Director’s Pioneer (DP1) applications.

The file must be a PDF and may be no larger than 3 MB. Follow these steps to upload a reference letter:

1. Click [Reference Letter](#). The **Submit Reference Letter** page will appear.





Figure 9: Commons Homepage (COM0001)

2. Enter the referee's and applicant's required information. Click **Continue**.






Figure 12: Submit Reference Letter Page (continued) (REG3007)




Figure 14: Status Information Page (STA4037)




Figure 15: IAR Grant Folder




Figure 16: Control Center (IAR0002)




Figure 17: Sample Email Text




Figure 18: List of Meetings Page (IAR0001)




Figure 19: Control Center Action Buttons (IAR0002)

## Meeting Materials

The length of the URL for adding and editing meeting materials has been increased to 500 characters.

## Simple List of Applications

A **Simple List of Applications** screen has been developed. This screen shows one line records of grant applications with the following data elements:

1. Order of Review
2. Grant Number (hyperlinked to the **IAR Grant Folder**).
3. PI Name (hyperlinked to a **Full Featured List of Applications** just for that PI)
4. Project Title
5. Number of Assigned Reviewers
6. Number of Submitted Critiques (counts files only, not scores)
7. Average Score
8. View All – PDF (to view a PDF file of all critiques for an application)
9. View All – Word (to view Preliminary Summary Statements)
10. Lower Half
11. Link to the List of Applications

All fields are sortable.




Figure 21: Click [By Application](#) or [By Reviewer](#) to view a **Full Featured List of Applications** (IAR0007).




Figure 22: **Control Center** (IAR0002)




Figure 23: List of All Applications Page (IAR0007)




Figure 24: List of Meetings Page (IAR0001)

On the **Score Matrix** and **List of Applications** pages, you may click on the PI's name to view a **Full Featured List of Applications** for the application record that was clicked on.




Figure 25: List of All Applications Page (IAR0007)

## Reviewer Critiques

You no longer have to navigate to the **List of Applications (By Reviewer)** in order to view a list of submitted critiques for one reviewer. By clicking on a reviewer's name in the **Control Center**, you will be able to view all applications assigned to that reviewer and applications for which the reviewer has submitted unassigned critiques. The same functionality is also available by clicking the reviewer's name on the **Full Featured List of Applications** screen.




Figure 26: List of Applications for Reviewer (IAR0007)




Figure 27: Control Center (IAR0008)

Sortable Review Order (as set up in the Peer Review system) has been added to all screens in IAR that display lists of applications. This column is visible to all reviewers and internal NIH and Operating Division (OPDIV) staff.




Figure 28: Preliminary Score Matrix (IAR0008)

## Discussant Critique Submission

If you are a discussant and have not submitted a critique, you may do so in the *Read* phase. However, once the critique is submitted in the *Read* phase you will not have the ability to resubmit the critique/score again during the *Read* phase.

## Preliminary Score Matrix

Once an SRA/GTA submits a critique for an unassigned reviewer, the list of reviewers will no longer display the reviewer who has already submitted the unassigned critique; as resubmission of the critique may now be done via the regular [Submit](#) link which appears on the **List of Applications** screen.

If you are a discussant on an application, you will be able to see the scores of other reviewers even if you did not submit your own critique/score and are designated as blocked. The concept of blocking is no longer applicable to discussants/readers.

A heading has been added to the Preliminary Scores column to specify that scores are from worst to best (left to right).




Figure 30: List of Meetings Page (IAR0001)

For SRAs/GTAs, the **Search** and **Reset** buttons have been moved under the query field on the **List of Meetings** screen.




Figure 31: List of Meetings Page (IAR0001)

# Financial Status Reports (FSR)

## Foreign Institutions

A new checkbox has been created on the FSR Search screen for selecting foreign grants. This checkbox grants the Office of Financial Management (OFM) the ability to generate CAS transactions for these foreign FSRs.

The Foreign checkbox for foreign institutions is available to all users of the FSR system regardless of role.




Figure 32: Financial Status Report Search Page (FSR8013)
